Important Information and Regulations

Important information and rules pertaining to admission for the session are as given below:

The candidate who applies for admission is advised to carefully read the same and it shall be presumed that he/she agrees to abide by the same.

- I. **Duration of the Programme** - **36 Weeks (17.08.2026 to 23.04.2027)**
- II. **Course Mode:** - **Full Time Regular Classes**
- III. **Medium of Instruction / Course** - **English.**
- IV. **Eligibility:**
 - Graduation in any Discipline (Pass in any Degree) from Recognized University.
 - **Age not more than 45 years** as on the commencement of the programme.
- V. **Course Content** - The Course Consists of **Two Semesters.**

VI. Regular Classes - The regular classes will be conducted on working days.

VII. Class Timings - 10.00 A.M to 5.00 P.M

VIII. Holidays - Saturdays, Sundays and Government Notified holidays.

IX. Attendance

A) Participants must attend at least 75% of their classroom sessions each semester. If they don't they won't be allowed to write the exams. If they meet the 75% attendance in the next semester, they can write the exams then. If they still don't meet the 75% attendance in the next semester, they will be disqualified from the course and will not be able to claim a refund of the course fee. The Director may grant exceptions for medical or other extraordinary reasons if valid proof is provided.

B) Biometric attendance is compulsory.

X. Examination and Assessment

a) **Internal Assessment** (50 Marks) is based on Case Presentation, Group Discussion, In-basket exercise, Quiz & Written Test.

b) **End Semester Examinations** (50 Marks) in Each Paper.

c) The candidates should secure at least 40% for pass in respect of each subject, including the internal assessment. The aggregate percentage of marks in each semester should be 45% for declaring a candidate successful /pass. If, under any circumstances, the candidate is unable to appear for the examination, he/ she should be treated as failed in that subject.

SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMS FOR THE FAILED CANDIDATES

Failed or absent candidates are allowed a maximum of three attempts to clear the examination, provided they must pass it within 2 years from the course completion date.

Supplementary examinations for failed or absent candidates in the first semester should be conducted alongside the second semester exams. For those who fail or absent in the second semester, the institute may organise the supplementary examinations for the failed candidates along with the subsequent course examinations. In case the subsequent course is not organised, a special / separate examination may be arranged for such candidates, so that they may get the chance to clear the examinations within the stipulated time as mentioned above.

It is the responsibility of the failed candidate to request the institute to conduct a supplementary examination. Such candidates should be given at least one month's notice before the supplementary examinations.

Candidates must pay Rs.500 per subject for the supplementary examination.

Observation Study Report and Presentation

As an integral part of the course, the candidates have to undertake compulsorily one week Observation Study Visit in any cooperative institutions and should submit a study report and presentation for the Marks of 50. Those who are absent in the study visit, will have to take up the study visit as per ICM rules.

Project and Viva-Voce

As an integral part of the course, the participants have to undertake project work in a cooperative institution and to submit a report for the assessment of 100 marks. The external viva-voce will be conducted for the evaluation of 50 marks.

Gradation

The candidates will be placed under the following categories/grades based on the overall percentage of marks obtained in the examination.

75% and above	- Distinction
65% but below 75%	- First Class
55% but below 65%	- Second Class
45% but below 55%	- Third Class
Less than 45%	- Failed, Reappearance is required

Course Fee

Rs. 25,000 + 18% GST = Total Rs.29, 500/- payable at the time of admission.

Note: After the commencement of the course, the fees will not be refunded)

Other Information

- ❖ Currently Hostel Facility not available due to the institute premises shifting process. However, there are many private homes/residence are available for affordable rent around areas.
- ❖ Hostel mess access is not permitted for day scholars. However, packed lunch will be provided at the lunch shed upon prior booking.
- ❖ Read the instructions and guidelines carefully before applying to the programme. No applications will be issued from the office and other forms of submission of applications will not be accepted. **(Detailed Guidelines for sending the application are given in Annexure-II)**
- ❖ Candidates who are waiting for the result of qualifying examination may also apply for admission with the clear understanding that their admission will remain provisional until they fulfill all the eligibility requirements of the concerned programme on the commencement date.

- ❖ A candidate whose qualifying examination is not recognized by any university, as identified during the verification shall not be eligible for admission. All such admissions (if provided) shall stand cancelled and fees paid (if any) will also be forfeited. The original certificates is a mandatory requirement during the verification process of the Institute.
- ❖ No correspondence shall be made to a candidate not selected for admission.
- ❖ All students are expected to abide by the rules and regulations, code of conduct, policy and procedures etc. governing the students, which will be laid down by the Institute from time to time.
- ❖ Eligibility rules as specified for course shall be strictly followed and shall not be relaxed under any circumstance. Candidate should satisfy himself/herself that he/she fulfills the eligibility requirements prescribed for admission to the programme.
